

## From Bishop Anderson House:

“Healing One, Healing the World” is the name of Bishop Anderson House’s annual benefit, and we will host it virtually once again on May 1st from 5p-6p. This year, we are inviting local churches to consider supporting the event through a new sponsorship category—Congregational Sponsorships. Creating this new category feels like a great way for us to maximize event fundraising while leveraging our opportunity to showcase the work and accomplishments of Bishop Anderson House this past year.

Congregational Sponsorships are also intended to be affordable, offered for a flat rate of \$250 (so, well below our traditional sponsorship rates of \$750). For your support, we will provide a dedicated social media acknowledgment, and we will offer your congregation an event “table,” that is, 12 admissions to the event. Bishop Anderson House is a Diocesan oversight ministry, one of several agencies that comprise Episcopal Charities. You may submit donations now to The Church of the Holy Family.
