**VESTRY MEETING
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 16, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. with prayer led by Donna Jones.

Roll Call. Present: Senior Warden Donna Jones, Junior Warden Ken Jacobsen, Vestry members Richard Cox, Elizabeth Cox, Melissa Jacobsen, Sydney Massey, Bob Reiff, Milton Smith. Absent: Vestry member Pat Guthrie.

Minutes of Last Vestry Meeting. It was moved by Milton Smith and seconded by Bob Reiff that the February 16, 2022 minutes be approved. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Senior Warden's Report.

Donna Jones completed the Parochial Report and submitted it on March 3. All but one vestry member reviewed it. Betty Lloyd's Letter of Agreement was submitted on March 14. Donna met with Carolyn Dillon. Donna meets with LaVerne on Mondays. Donna spoke with the Dean from St. John's on various matters including our rector search.

Junior Warden's Report.

Ken Jacobsen purchased Hydraulic Water Stop Cement and put it on the basement wall. He spoke with the man from Chicago Fire & Water. A storage unit (\$125 per month) will be in the parking lot for our possessions from the basement to be stored so that Chicago Fire & Water can do their work. A moving company will move the items from the basement.

Search Committee.

Melissa Jacobsen reported that Small Group meetings are to be held in the month of March.

Old Business.

- ⇒ Sexton Update: Liz Cox and Donna Jones spoke on the possibility of sharing a sexton with St. John's in Flossmoor.
- ⇒ Vestry Bios: Donna Jones asked that vestry members complete their bios and send a picture,
- ⇒ 2022 Planning Calendar: Milton Smith spoke on this. He and Bob Reiff need to get together regarding this.
- ⇒ Clergy: Father Bonney will be presiding on Good Friday at 7 p.m. He will also be with us on Palm Sunday. The Reverend Castillo will celebrate on Easter Sunday. Donna Jones is working on supply priest schedules for the future.

New Business.

- ⇒ Covid Protocol: The Diocese has not updated this recently. Donna will put in the bulletin that masks will be recommended for unvaccinated parishioners and optional for those who have been vaccinated. Resuming coffee hour will be considered in the near future.
- ⇒ Greenfields Lawn Care: Donna would like James Jones to talk to the person from this policy regarding a cancellation policy. If all is good, clean-up should be started in April.
- ⇒ Organ Tuning and Cleaning: Donna Jones said the organ was tuned in December. The invoice was sent on March 5. There was evidence of rodents and need for pipe work. Tim felt the organ was tuned well.
- ⇒ Directory Corrections and Reprinting: Carolyn Dillon met with Donna Jones about this.
- ⇒ Trinity Lutheran Church: A meeting will be held with members of Trinity on Monday, March 21, at 1 p.m. Donna Jones shared emails with the vestry regarding the grand piano in the nave and technical equipment (hard wiring).

Adjournment. Bob Reiff moved to adjourn and Milton Smith seconded it. The meeting adjourned at 9:47 p.m. following prayer led by Donna Jones.
